Chesapeake Bay Foundation Issues Report On PA Bay Cleanup Commitments



Pennsylvania will have to double and triple its efforts to install agricultural best management practices if the Commonwealth is to meet the milestone commitments it set by the end of 2011 to cleanup our rivers and streams, according to a new report issued by the Chesapeake Bay Foundation this week.

The report was given to members of the Senate Environmental Resources and Energy and Agriculture and Rural

Affairs Committees who held an informational meeting on the Chesapeake Bay TMDL.
